NOTICE TO OUR PASSENGERS DEPARTING FROM POINT JUDITH

If you are experiencing symptoms of the COVID-19 VIRUS, we would request the following:

- If you are experiencing symptoms of the COVID-19 virus (fever, shortness of breath and coughing), we would request that you contact your personal physician or the RI Dept. of Health (RIDOH), PRIOR TO TRAVELING on the ferry. You may call the RIDOH at (401) 222-8022.
- If your physician or the RIDOH recommends that you be tested for COVID-19, please do get tested PRIOR TO TRAVELING on the ferry to Block Island.
- If you do get tested for COVID-19, and you need to travel to Block Island, please contact Mr. William McCombe, our Director of Security and Block Island's EMA director at (401) 675-1234, and he will assist you in making those arrangements.
- We strongly recommend that you travel inside of a vehicle while onboard the ferry.

If you do NOT have symptoms of COVID-19, We request the following:

- We ask that you wash your hands thoroughly or utilize alcohol-based hand sanitizer prior to boarding the vessel, and please observe social distancing while on board the vessel. Social distancing indicates maintaining a minimum 6-foot distance between other passengers.
