

**2. Statement of the Project**

A. The work under this Contract involves providing all equipment, tools, labor and material to re-grade the parking area. The work includes the installation of the following (as shown on the contract documents):

1. Timber Guardrails
2. Guard Shack
3. Site Lighting
4. Entrance and Exit Gates
5. Pavement at Entrance and Exit

B. All excess material shall be removed and disposed of in accordance with RIDEM regulations.

C. The Contractor shall complete all work within 120 calendar days specified. Liquidated damages shall be assessed to the Contractor for failure to complete work within the specified timeframe.

D. Funding: This project is being funded through the Federal Aid Project No. FBD-REGT (025), R.I. Contract No. 2023CM-048. The specifications include specific requirements that must be followed. There are no exceptions. The following are some of the specific requirements.

1. The Contractor must comply with the American Iron & Steel Act.
2. Wages: All bidders must comply with the applicable provisions of Rhode Island General Laws, Chapter 37-12 and 37-13. The Department of Labor determines the customary and prevailing rate of wages paid to craftsmen, teamsters, and laborers in construction of public works by the state, and by cities, towns, and by persons contracting therewith for such construction. The latest general wage decision as determined by State Law at the time of this project shall be implemented by the Contractor for this project. The Contractor is responsible for complying with all wage laws found in the specifications. Further information may be obtained from the Office of the Department of Labor, Center General Complex, 1511 Pontiac Ave., Cranston, RI 02920.

3. There is a Goal of 7% for DBE participation on this project.
